LIFE is an all volunteer organization whose mission it is to promote the inclusion of persons with developmental disabilities into aspects of their natural community.

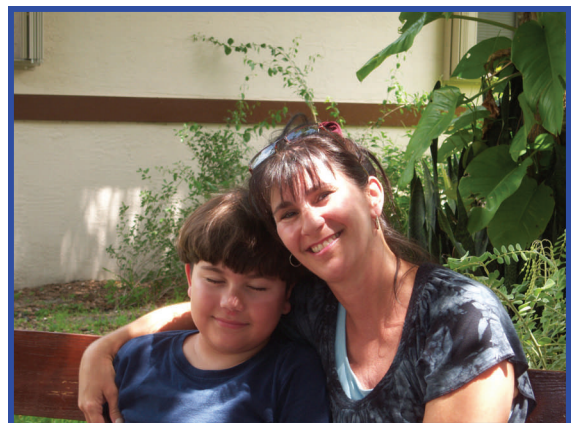
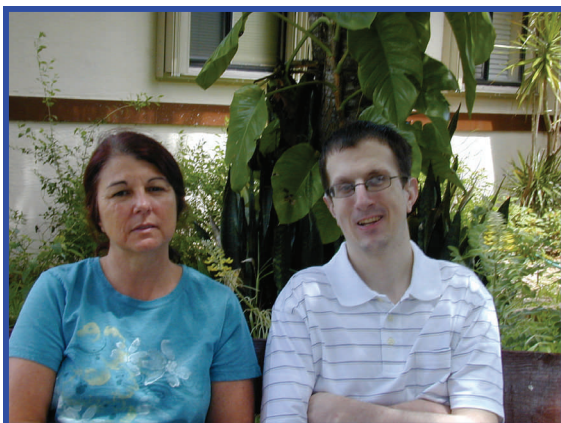
Dear Laura,
